Pleadings

(Assume Essential Facts)

Unit I

Draft a petition seeking judicial separation under the Indian Christian Marriage Act, 1872 on the ground that cruelty committed by husband against wife.

Unit II

Draft a Public Interest Litigation seeking directions on ill effects of fire crackers to the domain of human rights environmental concern and consumer welfare.

Unit III

Draft a bail application on behalf of accused who is arrested by police on charges of voluntarily causing hurt by dangerous weapons or means under section 324 of Indian Penal Code.

Unit IV

Draft an application under section 125 of Criminal Procedure Code for a Muslim divorced wife & two children

Unit V

Draft a eviction suit against a tenant for alteration done in the flat (assume necessary facts).

Unit VI

Draft a written statement on behalf of tenant on the ground that they were tenantable (necessary) repairs.

Unit VII

Draft a complaint under section 138 of the Negotiable Instrument Act & section 420 of the Indian Penal Code (Assume necessary facts).

Unit VIII

The accused were prosecuted for an offence under section 302, IPC & 149 of IPC, but were convicted under sections 304 & 149 of IPC. Draft an appeal against acquittal u/section 302 IPC and also Draft a revision petition for enhancement of the sentence awarded under section 304.
