Guidelines for Written Submission

1. The Written Submission must be **handwritten** in **English**.
2. The written submission shall consist of a **maximum of 5 pages / sheets written on both sides of ruled A4 Size Paper**. Additional two sheets shall be used for Title page and Bibliography respectively.
3. Writing references / bibliography is compulsory.
4. The pages should be numbered appropriately.
5. The Cover Page shall contain the following details:
 - a. Name of the student
 - b. Title of Submission
 - c. Subject
 - d. Roll number & Division
 - e. College Name
 - f. Name of the faculty to whom it is being submitted
6. The pages should be numbered appropriately.
7. Students are required to submit the written submission to the faculty at the time of the Presentation.

8. Students shall be required to give a Presentation on their written submission topics in the between 25th September to 1st October, 2024.
9. The schedule of the Presentation will be communicated in due course.
