COMPONENT I: JOURNAL

Students of II LL.B. are required to submit a hand written journal which shall contain the following units:

- Legal Aid Clinics

Unit III - Legal Services Authorities Act, 1987 – Object and features of the Act,

- Constitution, Powers & Functions in respect to National Legal Services Authority, State Level Service Authority and District Legal Services Authority
- Lok Adalats

GUIDELINES FOR SUBMISSION OF THE JOURNAL

1. The journal must be written on A/4 size (8.3 x 11.7 inches) paper and must spiral bound.
2. The Submissions must be HAND WRITTEN only.
3. The Journal should compulsorily contain the following particulars:
 - i. Cover Page
 - ii. Acknowledgment
 - iii. Table of Contents
 - iv. Pages must be numbered appropriately
4. The Cover Page of the Journal must contain the following details:
 - Subject : PRACTICAL TRAINING II
 - Name of Student
 - Roll number & Division
 - College Name
 - Faculty In-charge

COMPONENT II: VIVA VOCE

1. The Viva-Voce shall be based on the aforementioned Units.
2. The students must submit their journals to the concerned faculty on the day of Viva Voce.
3. The dates for VIVA-VOCE shall be communicated in due course. The students are requested to complete their journals by 15 JANUARY 2022.
