#### **WHO CAN PARTICIPATE?**

All current students from Second and Third Year LL.B of Jitendra Chauhan College of Law.

#### **RULES AND GUIDELINES**

1. The competition shall be held on **23<sup>rd</sup> November, 2021** from **5:25 pm** onwards.
2. The participants shall register for the competition by accurately filling the Google Form linked below:

3. The last date for registration is **16<sup>th</sup> November 2021**. No registrations shall be accepted after the aforementioned date.
4. The competition will be conducted on the Microsoft Teams Application.
5. All the participants must log into the meeting at 5:00 p.m. sharp i.e. 25 minutes before, for audio and video testing.
6. Every participant shall be allotted a unique code number upon registration. The participants are supposed to rename themselves on teams with this code number for the meeting.
7. The participants shall be addressed with their specific code number only. For the entirety of this competition, the participants are strictly prohibited from revealing their identity.
8. The participants are supposed to keep their cameras ON and microphones OFF throughout the meeting. The microphones shall be turned ON only when the moderator announces the participants turn to speak. It is mandatory to keep the camera ON while presenting the speech to assess the body language and presentation.
9. The participant must stay muted for the entire meeting until the Moderator specifically requests the participant to unmute. Any form of disturbance or interruption created while another participant is presenting the speech will lead to immediate disqualification.
10. The language for the Elocution competition shall be English only. The participants must not use any foul language or direct any unpleasant remarks towards fellow participants. Any use of such foul or obscene language will lead to disqualification.
11. The participants are expected to maintain proper conduct and behaviour.
12. The participants must dress in black and white formals only.
13. The participants must ensure that the background of their video is white or plain. There shall be no symbolic representations in the background.
14. The decision of the Judges shall be final and binding.

15. The organizers will resolve any contingencies that may arise during the course of this competition and shall be the final arbitrators regarding any doubts or grievances. The decision taken by the organizers shall be final and binding.
16. Participants are required to announce their topic, prior to commencement of Elocution.
17. Reading from notes is prohibited; however, participants may refer to the same for the purpose of quoting statistics, referring points or for citing case names, if any.
18. The Moderator shall make only 3 calls for each participant. Participants who do not report after the 3<sup>rd</sup> and final call is announced shall be marked absent.
19. The participants are requested to sit in a quiet place and to ensure good network connectivity. The organizers shall not be responsible if the participant is unable to present the speech due to poor network.
20. The organizers reserve the right to alter or change the rules or the procedure of the competition.

## **STRUCTURE OF THE COMPETITION**

1. Each speaker shall be allowed to speak for  $4+1 = 5$  minutes.
2. At the end of the 4<sup>th</sup> minute, there will be a warning bell, followed by the final bell at the end of 5<sup>th</sup> minute.
3. Participants are requested to adhere to the time limit.
